The knowledge and skill level of each trainee is evaluated and people who are capable of demonstrating an acceptable level of operational competence will be given Operator Certification cards and employee documentation.

Theory Training

The trainer will help the one training through a review of the theory training making use of several visual aids. The one training would work out of a manual which includes all the necessary regulations. Other subject matters like safe operating measures, different equipment kinds in addition to different associated applications and sizes, pre-use inspections and general work place safety are explored individually.

Theory Evaluation

The evaluation of the theory parts starts with a written exam, which focuses on the course concepts that was covered in the reference manual. Exams are graded and returned to the one training. The exams are then reviewed to ensure understanding and a minimum score of 70% is required so as to pass this portion of the training.

Practical Training

The practical training is covered in the hands-on portion. It is here that the ones training are shown the safe operating measures, like the shutdown and parking procedures and the pre-use check measures. Every trainee has the chance to operate the machinery and practice the skills they learned in Theory Training under the helpful eye of the program trainer in an environment which is safety controlled.

Practical Evaluation

The Practical Evaluation is where the ones training are evaluated to assure they have reached a minimum level of skill. The ones training are then assessed on an individual basis utilizing the machine in a reasonably challenging course environment. When the evaluation is finished, the trainees are de-briefed and given the opportunity to deal with any problems they might have regarding whichever part of the course. Every employer of a successful trainee would be sent the official records and documents shortly after the program has been completed.
