Hence, businesses prioritize warehouse safety.

The key to preventing accidents is understanding all of the potential warehouse dangers. Finds ways to lessen risks and always be alert for possible dangers and hazards. Do whatever is required to avoid accidents.

## General Hazards

Common kinds of danger in a warehouse setting are trips, falls and slips. These accidents are often caused when workers lose their balance or stumble over something which has not been put away properly. Removing or placing things from storage can lead to a slip or fumble, potentially causing both thing and employee to fall. The potential for slips, trips and falls is increased when employees are moving supplies on various kinds of floor surfaces and on different levels. Another common danger is getting hit by falling items. This is normally caused by failure to correctly stack stuff on shelves and other surfaces. Back injuries due to improper lifting methods are one more common danger.

There are inherent risks in utilizing and working around workplace machinery. Accidents can often be caused from the improper use of conveyors, hand trucks and forklift trucks. Warehouse tools, like for example skids, pallets, strapping and cutting tools, must be utilized carefully during unpacking, packing and loading.

Dangerous substances, combustible or flammable materials can pose danger while being stored inside a warehouse. Staff have to know how to take steps to protect themselves from health dangers when working around dangerous materials.
