The topics covered in the practical part consists of: Learn crane terminology; identify crane components and functions; identify rigging and wire ropes; utilize remote control; identify regulations and documents for rigging and wire rope; pre-use inspection on crane; perform proper lifting and lowering of loads; carry out rigging methods and utilize radio and hand signals.
